Topic: Future of Learning and Implications for Teaching	
Si Ling Primary School	Established in 1980, Si Ling Primary School is committed to nurturing its students to reach their full potential. The school's vision is to cultivate every student to be a scholar who leads and serves.
Gan Eng Seng Primary School	Established in 2002, Gan Eng Seng Primary School is named after school founder and prominent philanthropist Gan Eng Seng. The school aims to nurture learners with grit and citizens with heart.
Deyi Secondary School	Established in 1980, Deyi Secondary School seeks to inspire lives, nurture talents and realise dreams. The school offers distinctive programmes such as “Active Voice Broadcast Journalism” and “Nurturing Confident Communicators and Gracious Citizens through the Arts”.
