2011 Primary 1 Registration Exercise For Admission to Primary One in the Year 2012

Dear Parents

This insert provides essential information in preparation for your child's registration for admission to Primary One in 2012. We hope you will find this information useful.

Age Requirement

The Primary One Registration Exercise is for children who are at least 6 years old on 1 January at the year of admission. The 2011 Primary One Registration Exercise will be conducted from 29 June to 26 August 2011. Registration for each phase is conducted at the primary school that you wish your child to be admitted into (provided they are eligible for admission during that phase).

Compulsory Education (CE)

Under the Compulsory Education Act, Singapore Citizens born after 1 January 1996 and residing in Singapore are required to attend national primary schools regularly. Hence, if your child was born between **2 January 2005 and 1 January 2006 (both dates inclusive)**, you would have to register him or her at the **2011 Primary One Registration Exercise** for admission to Primary One in **January 2012**.

If a child has been medically assessed to be not ready or suitable for Primary One, approval for deferment of registration can be considered. To apply for deferment, an application can be made using the relevant form available at the Customer Service Centre, MOE Building, 1 North Buona Vista Drive, Singapore 138675 or downloaded from MOE's internet website at <http://www.moe.gov.sg/initiatives/compulsory-education/>

® Should the number of applications exceed the number of vacancies for Phase 2A to 2C (Supplementary), places will be balloted according to the home-school distance category in the following order of priority. Singapore Citizens will be given two ballot slips for each child, while Singapore Permanent Residents will continue to get one ballot slip per child.

- 1 Children living within 1 km of the school of choice
- 2 Children living between 1 km and 2 km of the school of choice
- 3 Children living outside 2 km of the school of choice

* At the end of Phase 2A(2), 50% of the remaining places will be allocated for Phase 2B and the other 50% for Phase 2C registrants in a school. In the event that less than 50% of the allocated vacancies are taken up at Phase 2B, the remaining vacancies will be carried forward to Phase 2C.

1 Children who are Singapore Citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents and who have not registered at any of the earlier phases are also eligible to register at this phase.

2 Should the number of applications exceed the number of vacancies, priority will be given in the following order to:
(a) Children who are Singapore Citizens
(b) Children who are Singapore Permanent Residents
(c) Children who are not Singapore Citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents

Within each of the above categories, balloting will be conducted if applications exceed the number of vacancies. For categories (a) and (b), balloting will be conducted according to the order of priority based on the home-school distance category for Phase 2A to 2C Supplementary. For category (c), balloting will be conducted regardless of home-school distance.

3 For children who have not been able to obtain a place at their school of choice after the balloting, their parents can approach another school with remaining vacancies to register. Registration will be done on a first-come-first-served basis.
