

## Information on Honour Rolls

**1. The Honour Rolls highlight schools that have performed exceedingly well in the following domains under the Masterplan of Awards for the year 2005:**

- a. Special Awards. The schools listed are winners of the School Distinction Award (SDA) or School Excellence Award (SEA).
- b. Academic Value-added. The schools listed have achieved at least an Achievement Award for the year.
- c. Physical and Aesthetics. The schools listed have achieved at least three years of sustainable results in at least one category<sup>1</sup> of Sustained Achievement Awards (SAA) in the year.
- d. Character Development. The schools listed have achieved at least a Development Award (DA)<sup>2</sup> for the year.
- e. Best Practice Award. The schools listed are winners of the respective categories<sup>3</sup> of BPA in 2005.
