

Scheme	Special Education Financial Assistance Scheme (SPED FAS)
Income eligibility criteria	Monthly gross household income (GHI) ≤\$3,000, or a monthly per capita income (PCI) ≤\$750
Benefits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% subsidy of school and miscellaneous fees • Free textbooks and school attire • School meal subsidy: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) For primary level students: Meal subsidies that pay for 7 meals per school week (b) For secondary level students: Meal subsidies that pay for 10 meals per school week • Public transport subsidy of \$17 per month or up to \$204 per annum
How to apply	You can collect a copy of the SPED FAS Application Form at your child’s school. Submit the completed form with all relevant documents directly to the school.
Additional financial assistance	<p>Your child may also receive:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subsidy for a new computer with the DigitalAccess@Home. • Enabling Transport Subsidy from the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) if he/she is taking school bus to and from school. • Taxi Subsidy Scheme from the MSF if he/she is only able to travel to school by taxi. <p>Besides SPED FAS, there are also school-based financial assistance that your child may qualify for.
