<b>Income eligibility criteria wef January 2026</b>	Monthly gross household income (GHI) ≤\$4,000, or a monthly per capita income (PCI) ≤\$1,000
<b>Benefits wef January 2026</b>	<p><u>Primary level</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 100% subsidy of miscellaneous fees</li> <li>• Free textbooks and school attire</li> <li>• Meal subsidies that pay for 7 meals per school week</li> <li>• Public transport subsidy of \$21 per month or up to \$252 per annum</li> </ul> <p><u>Secondary level</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 100% subsidy of school and miscellaneous fees</li> <li>• Free textbooks and school attire</li> <li>• Meal subsidies that pay for 10 meals per school week</li> <li>• Public transport subsidy of \$21 per month or up to \$252 per annum</li> </ul>
<b>How to apply</b>	You can apply <a href="#">online</a> . Alternatively, you can download the <a href="#">SPED FAS application form</a> or collect a copy at your child's school. Submit the completed form directly to the school.
<b>Additional financial assistance</b>	<p>Your child may also receive:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Subsidy for a new computer with the <a href="#">NEU PC Plus Programme</a>.</li> <li>• <a href="#">Enabling Transport Subsidy</a> from the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) if he/she is taking school bus to and from school.</li> <li>• <a href="#">Taxi Subsidy Scheme</a> from the MSF if he/she is only able to travel to school by taxi.</li> </ul> <p>You can approach your child's school to find out more about its school-based financial assistance.
