READING WITH YOUR CHILD

READING STRATEGIES



COMPLETION

Invite your child to complete the sentence by pausing before the end.



RECALL

Invite your child to recall events in the book.



OPEN-ENDED QUESTIONS

Ask your child open-ended questions which encourage more than one-word answers.



WH-QUESTIONS

Ask your child questions beginning with "who", what", where", "when", "why" and "how".



DISTANCING

Ask your child to make connections between the book and their personal experiences.
