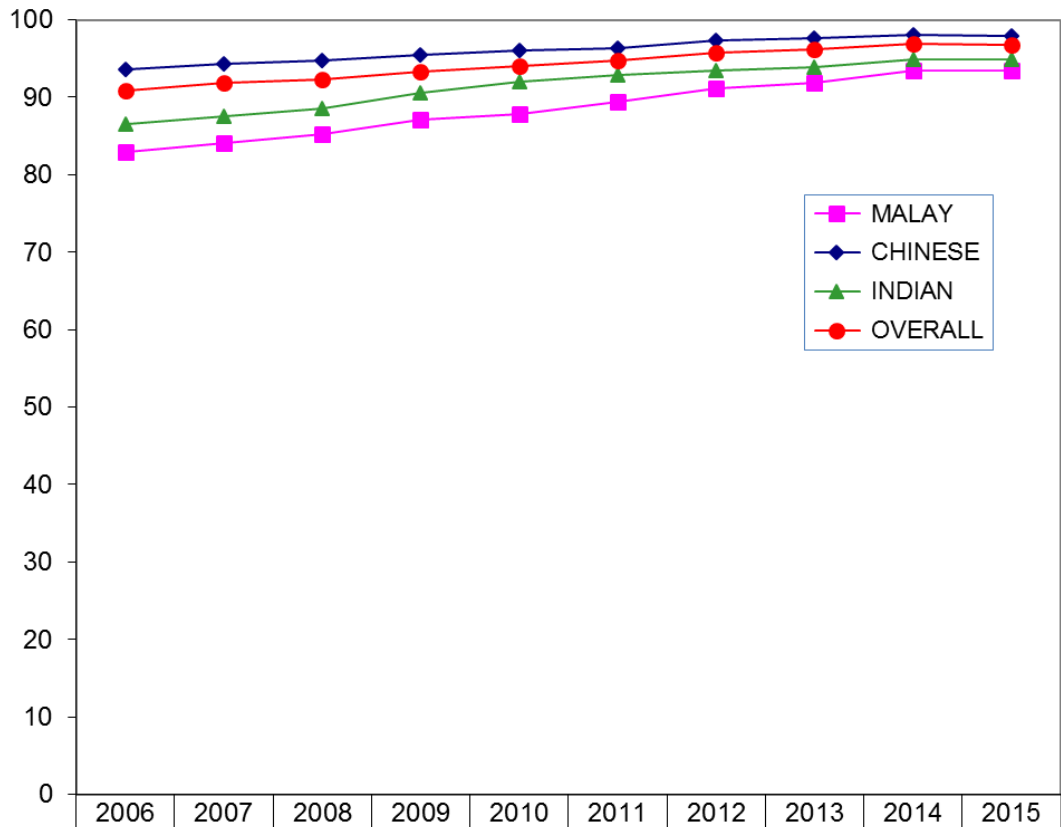


Chart A: Percentage of P1 Cohort that Progressed to Post-Secondary Education
