ELIGIBILITY AND EVALUATION CRITERIA AND TERMS FOR THE SOCIAL SCIENCE AND HUMANITIES RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP

- 1. Nominees for the Social Science and Humanities Research Fellowship should fulfil the following eligibility criteria:
 - a) Are Singapore citizens;
 - b) Have obtained their PhD degrees (or equivalent terminal degrees in their disciplines); and
 - c) Not holding a tenured position.
- 2. Nominees will be evaluated based on the following considerations:
 - a) Research track record, including:
 - i) Achievements in research/ publications;
 - ii) Grants, awards and/ or prizes won; and
 - iii) Ability to manage the research grant requested.
 - b) Strong potential and motivation to pursue an academic career and be a future university leader;
 - c) Potential of the proposed research project in having a demonstrable impact on their career progression in becoming an independent researcher; and
 - d) Potential impact of the proposed research project and its potential to contribute to knowledge and practice.
- 3. The terms of the Social Science and Humanities Research Fellowship are as follows:
 - a) Tenable for a term of five years. There is no extension of the Fellowship beyond the five years;
 - b) Tenable for research in any social science and humanities discipline, with the area of research of relevance to Singapore and/ or the region;
 - c) Provides a research grant of up to S\$1 million over five years;
 - d) Appointment as faculty in the AUs hosting the awardees; and
 - e) Awardees and their research should be based in Singapore except for overseas fieldwork or overseas visits.
