¹ Students who receive 100% fee subsidy will receive free textbooks and school attire (for Secondary levels), \$900 bursary (for Pre-university levels) and transport subsidies. For Singaporean students enrolled in the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in Government-funded schools, MOE will provide 100% examination fee subsidy to these students as well. Examination fees for GCE O- and A-Levels have been fully waived for all Singaporean students in Government-funded schools from 2015.
