## MOE's efforts to meet demand for places in Special Education Schools

Date	Developments	
2013	Metta School's extension block which officially opened in 2013, provided an additional 150 school places for students with Mild Intellectual Disability (MID), as well as those with a combination of MID and ASD.	
2013	Delta Senior School, catering to students with MID as well as those with a combination of MID and ASD, moved into its new purpose—built vocational school with specialised facilities in July 2013. Since January 2014, the school has offered two programmes, namely the Workforce Skills Qualification (WSQ) Work Experience Programme, and the LEAD Programme (renamed from the Transition Programme in 2017).	
2017 - 2018	Three government-funded SPED schools which offer ASD programmes for students with moderate-to-severe ASD, expanded their school places.  Autism Association Singapore (AAS), AWWA and Rainbow Centre (RC) each opened one additional campus. The three additional campuses can take in 75 additional students per year.  Information on the three additional campuses are found in the table appended:
