## Activities held at external venues that can resume

- CCAs held at venues with specific facilities: E.g. Golf, Bowling, Fencing Shooting, Swimming, Artistic Swimming, Waterpolo, Canoeing, Rock-climbing and Sailing etc.
- SwimSafer 2.0.
- Activities organised by the HQs of Uniformed Groups, which are held in the respective UG HQs and external training venues. This also applies to activities organised by schools as part of their core UG programme.
- Learning Journeys, Values-In-Action and enrichment activities which are held at venues accessible to general public.
- Student Work Attachments, Student Research Attachment Programme in Research Institutes/Laboratories, H3 Science Research Programme at Autonomous Universities (AUs)/Research Institutes, Elective Modules and Advanced Elective Modules at ITE and Polytechnics.

## Activities involving different schools that can resume

- SP-CCA.
- Junior Sports Academy.
- Inter-School CCA Collaborations (e.g. combined Physical Sports/Visual and Performing Arts CCA team practices etc.).
- Singapore National Youth Chinese Orchestra and Singapore National Youth Orchestra.

## Activities involving wind instruments and Speech and Drama programmes <u>can</u> resume

• In line with the national advisory, wind instrument playing and Speech and Drama programmes may resume with additional safe management measures. These activities are capped at five wind players or five drama performers, with the mandatory presence of one teacher/instructor.

## CCAs and activities that remain suspended

- Singing.
- Activities with high level of body contact such as Taekwondo sparring, Rugby scrum and tackle.
- Overnight camps.
