TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE PRO-TEM COMMITTEE

- 1. Establish the vision, mission and corporate branding of the proposed alliance, which will be Singapore's first university of the arts
- 2. Develop the governance structure of the alliance/university, including its organisational structure, the role of the central body to be set up, and the relationship between the central body and members
- 3. Develop the academic governance framework for the alliance/university, including the requirements for the awarding of degrees by the central body
- 4. Develop key aspects of the operating model in areas such as academic governance, finance, procurement, IT and student services, including the extent of its centralisation and the delineation of roles, responsibilities and accountability between the central body and its members
- 5. Establish the constitution of the central body
- 6. Establish a roadmap for the alliance and the university of the arts for the first few years after its formation
