

Annex B: Examples of school's partnerships with industry

As part of Yuying Secondary School's Applied Learning Programme (Business & Entrepreneurship) – Fostering Innovation through Design Thinking, the school works with Super Bean International Pte Ltd to engage students in the process of creating and marketing a new food product. This provides students the opportunity to learn through real-world tasks. Company representatives also share their entrepreneurship journey, highlighting the importance of values such as resilience and responsibility in growing a company and thriving in today's economy.

Geylang Methodist School (Secondary) partners with ComCrop Pte Ltd to support Secondary Two students in learning about urban agriculture in Singapore for its Applied Learning Programme (Sustainability) – GeMs_Applied Learning Programme in Science. Under this programme, students participate in hands-on experiments and grow vegetables using the hydroponics systems in the school's greenhouse. ComCrop Pte Ltd has also engaged Secondary Three students in discussions about the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on urban agriculture and food security both locally and globally. These opportunities enable students to consolidate their learning and put theory into practice.
