

SUPPLEMENTARY PLACEMENT EXERCISE (SPE)

USER GUIDE ON ACCOUNT CREATION



IMPORTANT NOTES

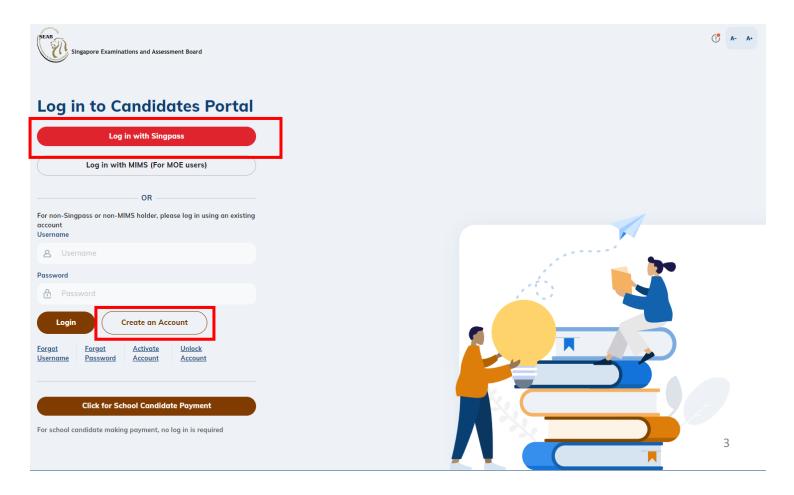
- 1. SEAB's Candidates Portal (CP) is a self-help portal for Returning Singaporeans (RS) to keep track of their registration status and to receive test-related documents and notices in preparation to sit for the SPE.
- 2. All applicants **must first create an individual account in CP** using their full personal particulars before they are able to register for the SPE. They should provide the following information for account creation:
 - a. Applicant's personal particulars (e.g. NRIC, Date of Birth).
 - b. A valid e-mail address (This email is required for 2FA).
 - c. Local or Overseas contact number of self and next-of-kin.
- 3. Upon a successful account creation, applicants can log into CP via Singpass (for Singpass users) or Account Username and Password (for non-Singpass users).
- 4. Account creation does <u>not</u> guarantee a place in the SPE. However, **applicants' personal details** provided in account creation will be used for registration for the SPE and **should not be amended**.
- 5. Each applicant can only create <u>ONE</u> account. When multiple accounts of the same person are detected by the system, the applicant will not be able to enter the registration phase to secure a place for the SPE when registration commences.



Instructions to create an account

- 1. Use a valid personal email address to complete the following steps to create an account.
- 2. Access the Candidates Portal via https://myexams.seab.gov.sg/auth/login
- 3. From the Candidates Portal login page,
 - a) click on **Log in with Singpass** for student applicants with a Singpass Account; or
 - b) click on **Create an Account** for student applicants who do not have a Singpass Account.

For applicants without a Singpass account, skip to page 11.





For Student Applicants with a Singpass Account



a) For student applicants with a Singpass Account

If you are eligible for Singpass, you must register for SPE tests with your Singpass credentials.

Please visit the Singpass website for details on how to register or activate your Singpass account before registering for the SPE tests.

After clicking on **Log in with Singpass** on the Candidates Portal login page,

- 1. You will be redirected to the <u>Singpass login page</u>. Launch your Singpass app and tap on the **Scan** button.
- 2. Scan the QR code shown on the screen.
- 3. You will be prompted to use either of the following to verify your identity:
 - Fingerprint (for selected smartphones), or
 - 6-digit passcode

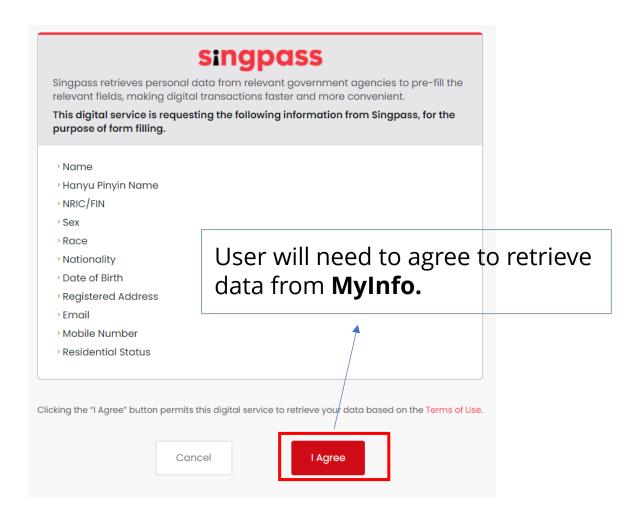


- 1. User will be directed to **Singpass** login page
- 2. Scan the QR code shown on the screen.
- 3. Log into **Singpass** with
- Fingerprint, or
- 6-digit passcode

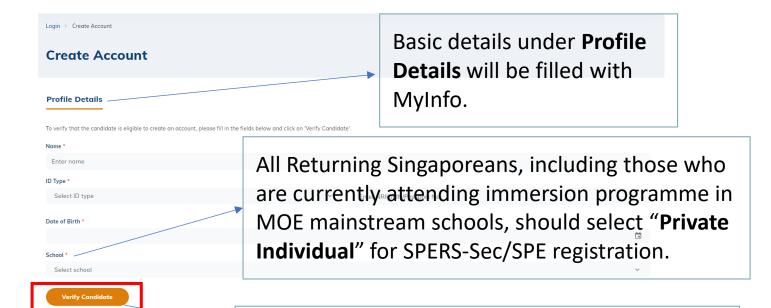
- 4. Provide your details with one click on **Retrieve Myinfo** to save time and avoid errors in filling up the application form.
- 5. Upon successfully logging in using Singpass, you will be automatically directed back to the Candidates Portal Account Creation page.



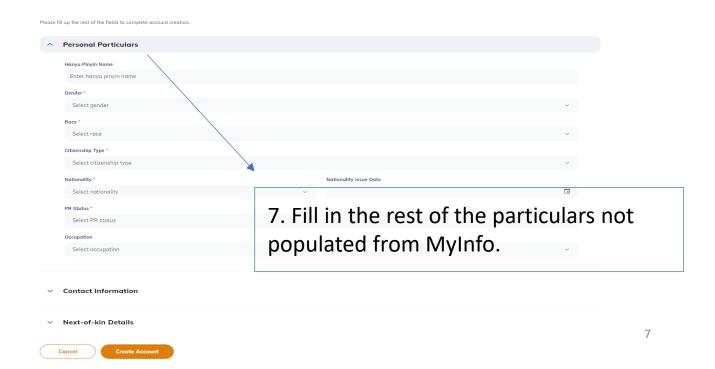


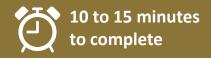
a) For student applicants with a Singpass Account

At the Account Creation page, you should see that your profile details have been pre-filled.



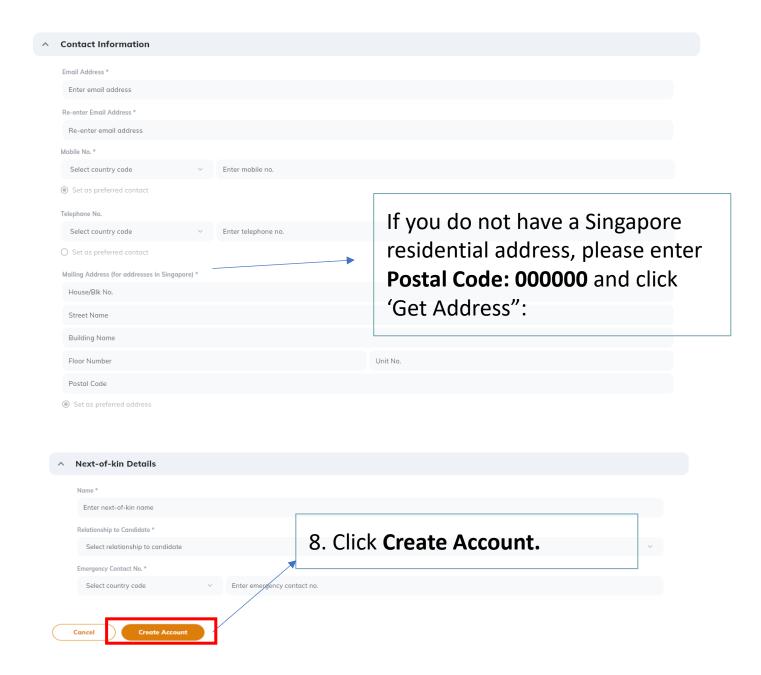
6. Click on **Verify Candidate** for an eligibility check. This is a required step before you can fill in/edit the rest of your particulars.

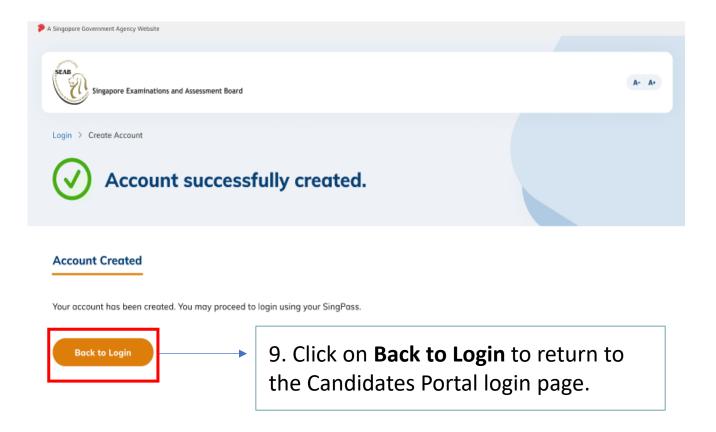
All applicants are required to update their residential addresses to ensure that they remain contactable.

Upon successful creation of the account, you will see the image below.



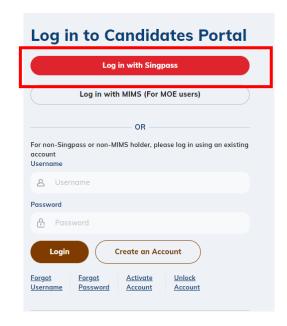

Logging in

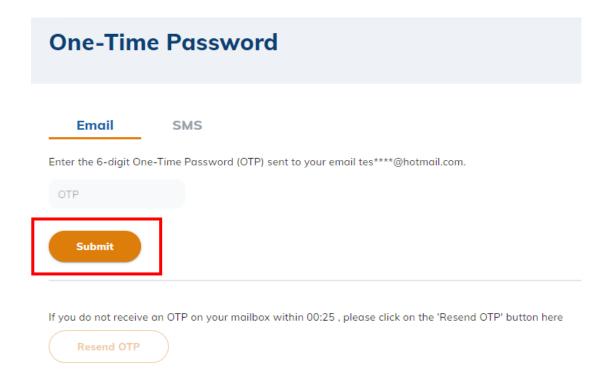


- a) For student applicants with a Singpass Account
- 1. Click on **Log in with Singpass** to sign in to Candidates Portal.

You can only use Singpass to log into Candidates Portal.



- 2. Once you have signed in, the next screen will prompt you to enter the One-Time Password (OTP) which will be sent via Email or SMS (only for Singapore-registered mobile number).
- 3. Click **Submit** after keying in the OTP in the required field.





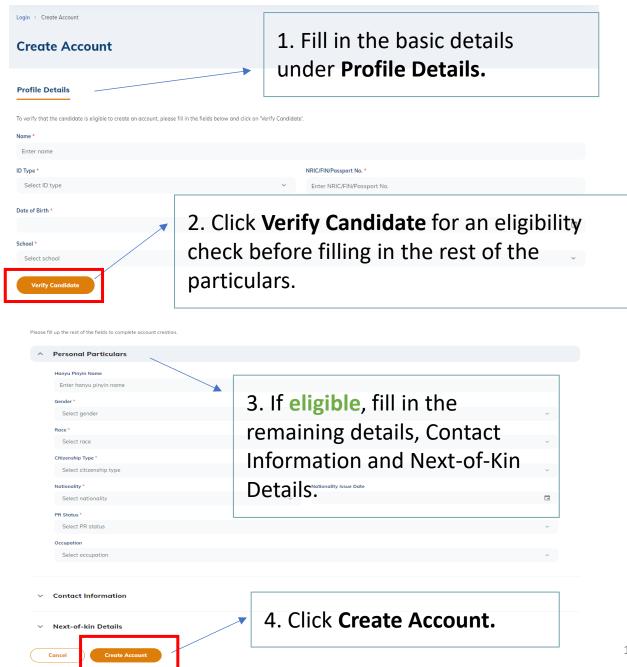

b) For student applicants without a Singpass Account

If you are not eligible to hold a Singpass Account, you MUST create an account in the Candidates Portal using your NRIC (also known as National ID number).

You will NOT be eligible for SPE if you use your passport details to create an account.

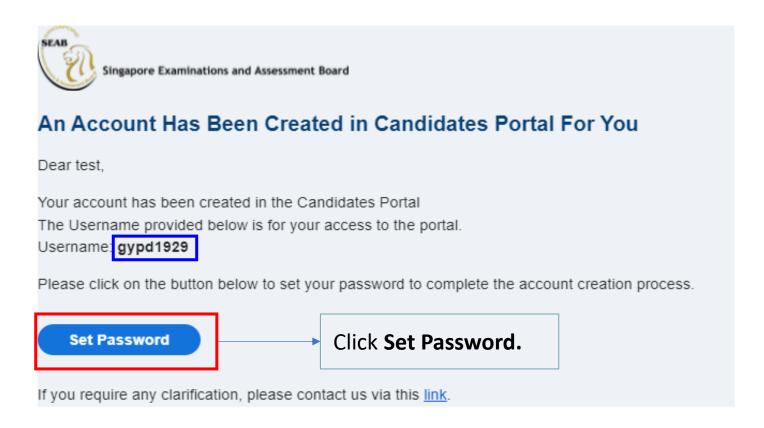




b) For student applicants without a Singpass Account

- 5. An email will be sent to your valid personal email address with the following:
 - Account Username (This is the Username for all subsequent logins.)
 - Instructions to set your password.

Please check your spam folder if you did not receive the email.



- 6. Click on **Set Password** to set a password for your account. Please note that the system-generated Username cannot be changed.
- 7. Set a password for your Candidates Portal account.

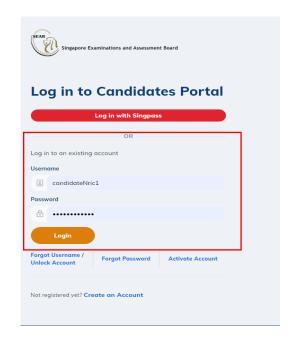

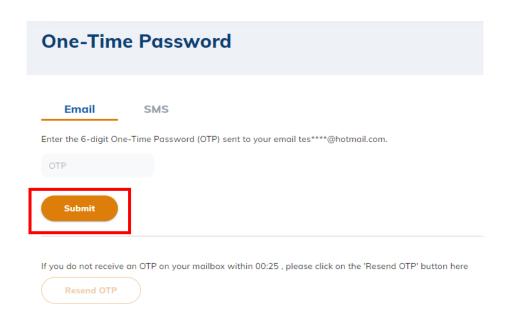
b) For student applicants without a Singpass Account

To sign in to your account,

- 1. Enter your system-generated Username and Password you have set.
- 2. Click Login.



- 3. The next screen will prompt you to enter the One-Time Password (OTP) sent via Email or SMS (only for Singapore-registered mobile number).
- 4. Click **Submit** after keying in the OTP in the required field.
