

2019 Primary One Registration Exercise For Admission To Primary One In The Year 2020

Dear Parents

This insert provides essential information in preparation for your child's registration for admission to Primary One (P1) in 2020. We hope you will find the information useful.

Age requirement

The 2019 P1 Registration Exercise is for children born between 2 January 2013 and 1 January 2014 (both dates inclusive). The children will be at least 6 years old on 1 January at the year of admission.

Compulsory Education (CE)

Under the Compulsory Education Act, Singapore Citizens born after 1 January 1996 and residing in Singapore are required to attend national primary schools regularly. Hence, if your child was born between **2 January 2013 and 1 January 2014 (both dates inclusive)**, you would have to register your child at the **2019 P1 Registration Exercise** for admission to P1 in **January 2020**.

If a child has been medically assessed to be not ready or suitable for P1, approval for deferment of registration can be considered. To apply for deferment, an application can be made using the relevant form available at the Customer Service Centre, MOE Building, 1 North Buona Vista Drive, Singapore 138675 or downloaded from MOE's website at <https://www.moe.gov.sg/>.

A list of schools grouped by Planning Area (refer to the back of this insert) is provided for your information.

Registration details

The 2019 P1 Registration Exercise will be conducted on the dates listed in the schedule below.

For Phase 1 to Phase 2C Supplementary, registration for each phase is conducted at the primary school that you wish your child to be admitted into (provided they are eligible for admission during that phase). The hours of registration are from 8.00 am to 11.00 am and from 2.30 pm to 4.30 pm on each scheduled registration day.

If you are registering your child during Phase 2C or Phase 2C Supplementary, you can register online using the Primary One Internet System (P1-IS). The P1-IS serves as a channel to facilitate the registration of your child. You may refer to the MOE website (<https://www.moe.gov.sg/>) for more information on P1-IS.

Detailed information on the P1 Registration Exercise will be published in the media before the registration begins. The information is also available on the MOE website (<https://www.moe.gov.sg/>) from May 2019 onwards.

Note:

- ® 1) MOE will reserve 40 places in every primary school for registrants in Phase 2B and 2C to ensure continued open access to all primary schools. The 40 places will be reserved in Phase 2B and 2C (20 places for each phase) before the start of the P1 Registration Exercise.
- ® 2) Singapore Citizens (SCs) will be given absolute priority over Singapore Permanent Residents (PRs) when balloting is necessary in a specific phase. SCs and PRs will continue to be eligible for the same phases, and all applicants will be admitted if the total number of applications in any phase does not exceed the number of vacancies. However, if the number of applications exceeds the number of vacancies in a specific phase, SCs will be admitted first ahead of PRs, before home-school distance is considered.
- ® 3) Should the number of SC applications exceed the number of vacancies in a specific phase and home-school distance category, places will be balloted according to the home-school distance category in the following order of priority:
 - (a) Children living within 1km of the school of choice
 - (b) Children living between 1km and 2km of the school of choice
 - (c) Children living outside 2km of the school of choice
- ® 4) Should the number of SC applications be less than the number of vacancies in a specific phase, all SCs will be admitted first. The remaining vacancies in that phase will be balloted amongst the PRs based on the above home-school distance category.
- At the end of Phase 2A(2), 50% of the remaining places (including the 40 reserved places) will be allocated for Phase 2B and the other 50% for Phase 2C registrants in a school. In the event that there are vacancies left at the end of Phase 2B, the remaining vacancies will be carried forward to Phase 2C.

- # 1) Non-SC / non-PR children who wish to seek admission to P1 in 2020 are required to undergo a two-step process:
 - Step 1: Submit an online 'indication of interest' form via the MOE P1 website, from 4 to 10 June 2019; **and**
 - Step 2: Non-SC / non-PR children who have submitted the 'indication of interest' form and are notified in October by MOE that they can be offered a P1 place in a school, must register in-person at the designated schools during Phase 3 of the 2019 P1 Registration Exercise (in late October 2019).
- # 2) Non-SC / non-PR children who do not submit the 'indication of interest' form to MOE by 10 June 2019, 4.30pm will not be able to register during Phase 3 of the P1 Registration Exercise.
- # 3) Parents of non-SC / non-PR children should note the 'indication of interest' is not considered as registration. Parents of non-SC / non-PR children should note that admission is **not guaranteed** as there are limited vacancies remaining for non-SC / non-PR children after places are allocated to SC / PR children. As admission is not guaranteed, parents of non-SC / non-PR children are advised to consider alternative educational options well ahead of time.
- # 4) Parents of non-SC / non-PR children are to indicate their interest online from 4 June 2019, 9.00am to 10 June 2019, 4.30pm. MOE will centrally process all the applications **after** all SC / PR children have registered in earlier phases. MOE will inform parents of non-SC / non-PR children in October 2019 via postal mail, on whether their children can be offered a P1 place in a school. Parents of non-SC / non-PR children who can be offered a P1 place are required to register for the place in-person at the designated school in late October 2019 during Phase 3 of the 2019 P1 Registration Exercise, with the original documents for verification.
- # 5) Parents of non-SC / non-PR children can visit the P1 Registration website for more information on admission to P1 in 2020.
- ^ For all non-SC / non-PR children who have indicated interest, including those who cannot be offered a P1 place.
