

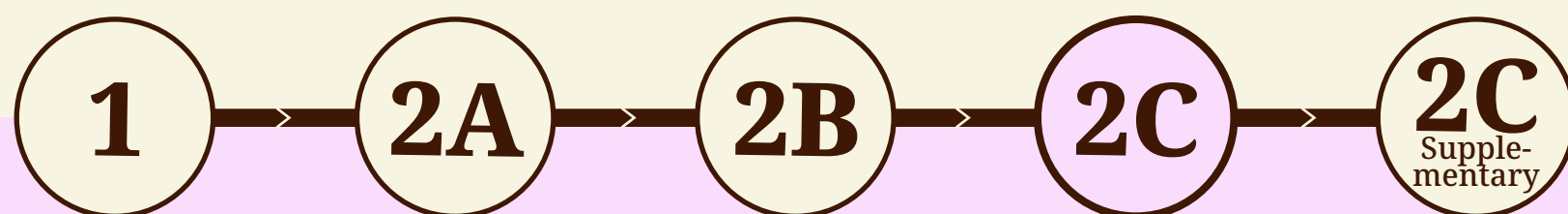

Phase 2C

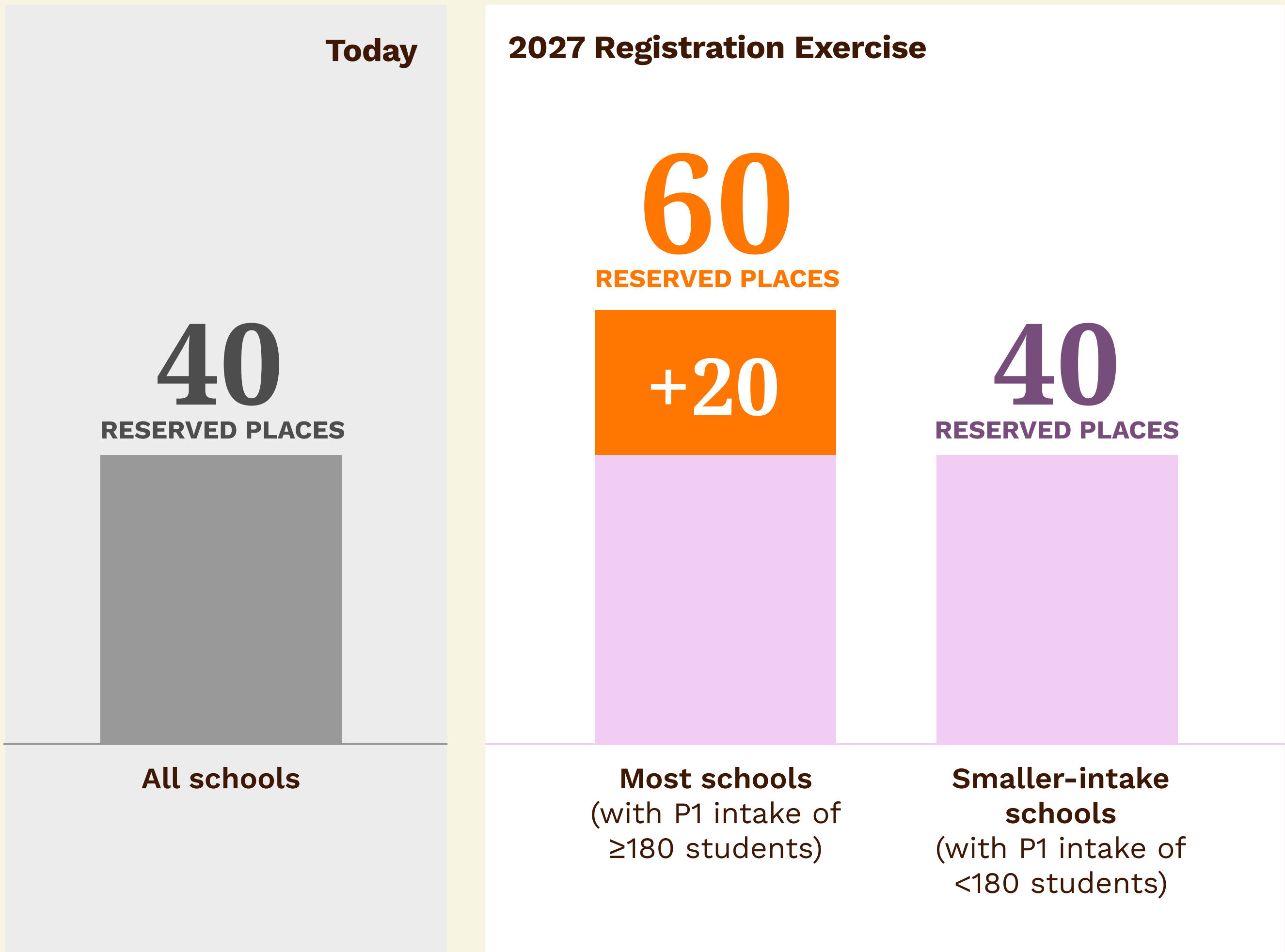
From the 2027 P1 Registration Exercise
(For children starting P1 in 2028)



**The P1 Registration Framework has been refined over the years.
These changes seek to further improve access and support
greater inclusivity in our primary schools.**

Increase in Number of Reserved Phase 2C Places from 40 to 60

This change aims to improve access for children regardless of whether they have prior connections to a primary school, and will apply to all schools, except schools with smaller intakes.

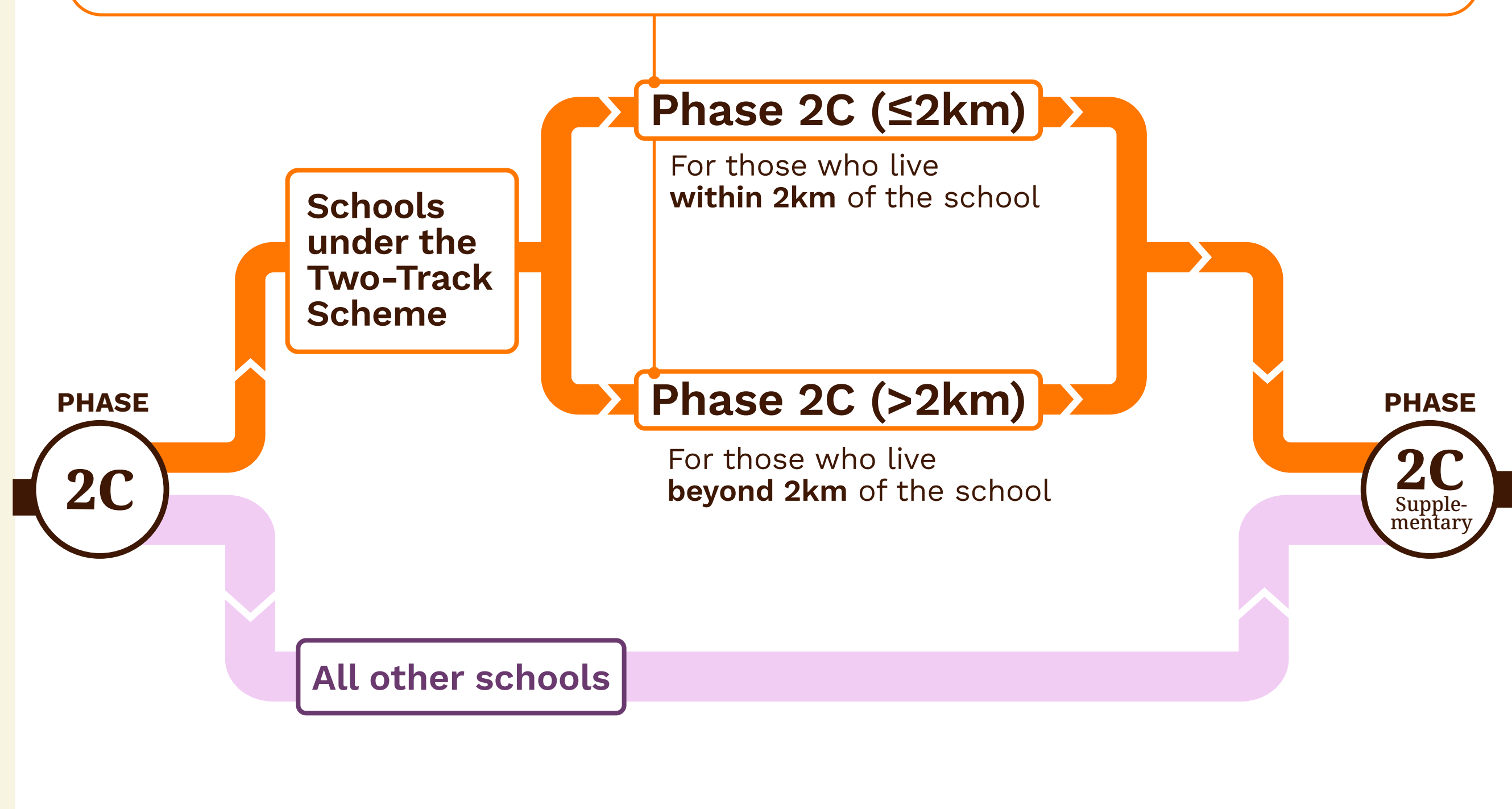


New Two-Track Scheme

For schools located in neighbourhoods where the proportion of public housing is significantly lower than the national average¹

This will preserve access for children living near the school, while opening the school to a more diverse socio-economic mix of families beyond those living in their immediate neighbourhood.

- Phase 2C places (including all reserved places) will be **equally distributed** between these two tracks.
- If there are remaining places in one track (i.e. all Singapore Citizen (SC) applicants in that track are admitted), the remaining places will flow to SC applicants in the other track.²
- If the number of applicants exceeds vacancies in a track, balloting will be conducted.
- There will be no home-school distance priority within each track.



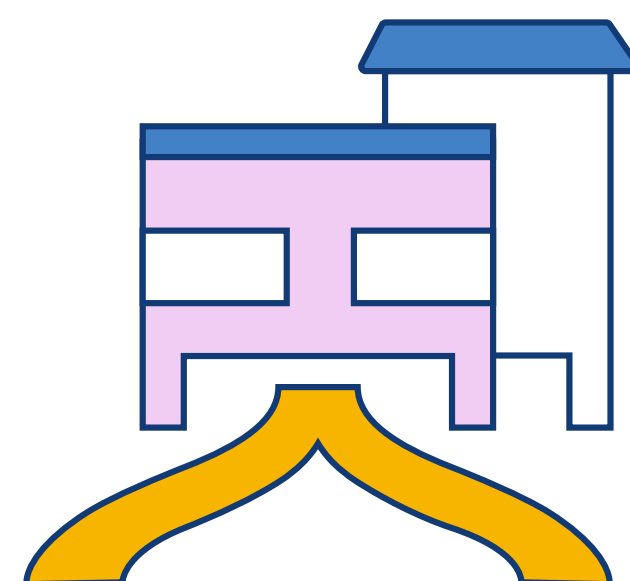
¹ About 8 in 10 of Singapore's resident population live in public housing (HDB flats).

² All SC applicants under both tracks will be admitted first, before Permanent Resident applicants are considered for any remaining vacancies thereafter.

For a start, MOE will implement the Two-Track Scheme in 12 schools, where public housing accounts for less than 40% of dwelling units within 2km, from the 2027 P1 Registration Exercise.

This list will be reviewed periodically, taking into account changes in the schools' surrounding housing profiles as well as experience with implementation. However, we do not expect frequent changes to the list, as housing profiles do not change drastically over a short period of time.

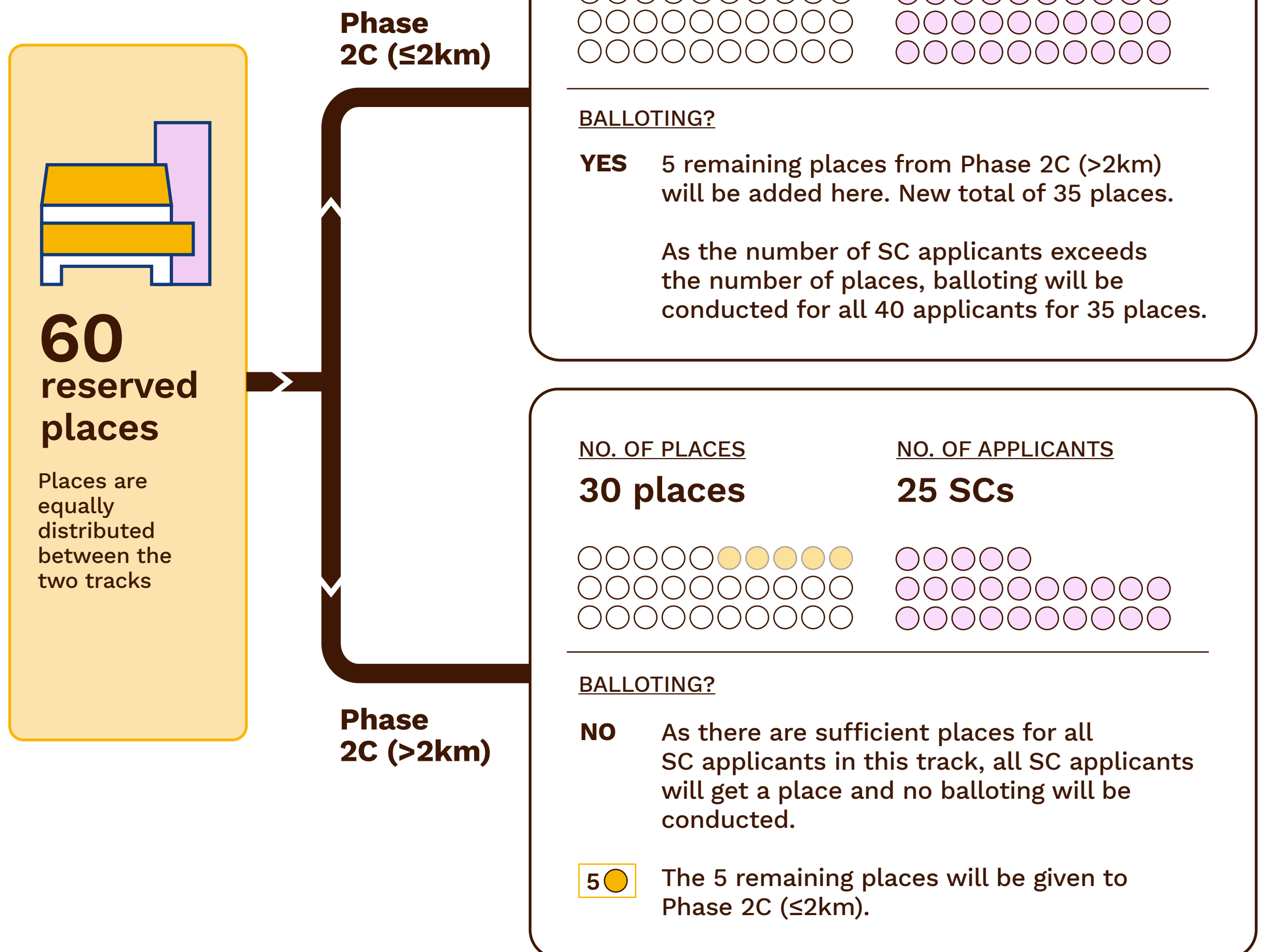


How will applicants be posted and balloting be conducted?

Here's an example.

There will be no home-school distance priority within each track. If the number of Singapore Citizen (SC) applicants exceeds the number of places in a track, balloting will be conducted.

○ Singapore Citizen (SC) ● Remaining places from other track



If there are remaining places in one track after all SC applicants have been posted, the remaining places will flow to SC applicants in the other track.
