Information about the Mother Tongue Language Elective Programme

The Mother Tongue Language Elective Programme was introduced in 1990 at the pre-university level (LEP-JC) to nurture students with a high level of proficiency in their Mother Tongue Languages and enhance their appreciation of Literature. The programme also aims to develop a sustainable pipeline of bilingual and bicultural talents who can forge meaningful connections with the region and contribute to the cultural fabric of the nation.

The Chinese Language Elective Programme (CLEP-JC) was the first to be launched in 1990. Building on its success, the Malay Language Elective Programme (MLEP-JC) was introduced in 2001, followed by the Tamil Language Elective Programme (TLEP-JC) in 2020.

The programme was subsequently expanded to the secondary level (LEP-Sec) in 2020 across the Chinese, Malay and Tamil Languages (CLEP-Sec, MLEP-Sec and TLEP-Sec).
