The International Olympiads bring together talented students from around the world, challenging and stimulating their minds in the spirit of competition. They are global platforms to stretch our students in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) disciplines.

Through rigorous tests, students demonstrate their mastery of mathematical and scientific concepts. In addition, their experimental and programming skills are put to the test in the Science and Informatics Olympiads respectively. By pitting their skills and knowledge against international peers at the Olympiads, our students are exposed to an enriching learning experience and motivated to strive for excellence in the international arena.
